# Maline Greenway open houses

After meeting with citizens and community leaders last fall to obtain valuable input on the new Maline Greenway, a walking and bike trail connecting 10 communities in North St. Louis County, Great Rivers Greenway will host two open houses.

The first will be held 6-8 p.m. Thursday, March 24, at the Lewis & Clark Branch Library, 9909 Lewis and Clark Blvd. in Moline Acres; and the second will take place 6-8 p.m. Tuesday, March 29 at Ferguson Middle School, 701 January Ave. in Ferguson.

Free snacks and children's crafts will be available during the event.

The new greenway will start in Berkeley, travel east along the Maline Creek and end at the Riverfront Trail, near the 112-acre North Riverfront Park in the city of St. Louis. Once completed, Maline Greenway will connect to the North Riverfront Trail in the Mississippi Greenway on the east, and on the west, the greenway will connect with the St. Vincent Greenway, which continues southeastward to Forest Park.

Maline Greenway will consist of approximately 7.5 miles of linear parks and trails, providing North County with a direct route to the Mississippi Riverfront.
